Sixth Day Enrollment Report

The Lake County Regional Office of Education has released the “Sixth Day” enrollment numbers, and Big Hollow has seen a significant increase. These numbers pertain to the county’s 46 public school districts for the past five years, September 2005 to September 2009.

By percentage, the three school districts with the largest increase were:

- Big Hollow - 38.4%
- Bannockburn - 17.2%
- Grayslake High School - 16.8%

The actual student growth for the three districts was reported as:

- Big Hollow - 465
- Bannockburn - 21
- Grayslake - 411

By percentage, the three school districts with the largest decreases were:

- North Chicago - 15.7%
- Winthrop Harbor - 12.8%
- Mundelein - 11.9%

The actual student decreases for the three districts was reported as:

- North Chicago - 725
- Winthrop Harbor - 97
- Mundelein - 245

All 46 public school districts combined had an increase of 1.2% which is 1,740 students.
