This will be the fifth year the National Association of Women in Construction, also known as NAWIC, will be sponsoring a LEGO Building Contest at the elementary school. Students will receive 100 LEGO blocks, a rock, a piece of string, and a piece of tin foil. They will then create a structure out of the materials given, such as a wheelchair ramp to help kids get into a school building. The children need to use all the materials somehow and once they are finished, they present their structure to the judges. The top 3 winners each earn prizes and go on to compete in regional and state levels. Students have a lot of fun and parents enjoy seeing the kids compete with other schools.
