

Adopt an Island Program

Purpose: to assist Big Hollow in the maintenance of the landscaped areas of the District and encourage community participation within the district, while allowing the district to put more dollars in the classroom.

Who is Eligible?

Big Hollow organizations, clubs, classrooms, staff and families
Community organizations
Community members and families

Program guidelines

Applicants will complete an application.
Upon acceptance, applicants will be required to sign a liability waiver.
Applicants may chose an area or be assigned an area.

Areas assigned will be maintained (weeds removed, bushes pruned, dead plants removed) by the applicants at their expense, on their own time.

New plantings may be added with permission from the district.

Areas may be maintained during non- school hours at the applicant's own time.

If working on the area during school hours, the applicant must report to the office upon arrival and sign in at the office, produce identification and be issued a visitors badge.

The district will provide a garden sign to read:

Areas will be adopted on a year to year basis. Areas will be evaluated on regular basis. Areas not being properly maintained will be put back up for adoption.
