From the Office

Just a reminder that all visitors to all the Big Hollow Schools are required to stop in the school office and present a valid driver's license to obtain a visitor's badge. The visitor's badge must be worn and visible at all times while in the building and returned to the office when leaving. You must have a visitor's badge to go to your child's classroom.

The school day begins at 8:40. If your child arrives late, after 8:40, you must come into the school office and sign them in. Students are not to be dropped off before 8:25 each morning.

If you or another designated adult will be picking up your child from school, please send a note or call the office before 3 p.m. so we can inform your child to not go on the bus.
