LUNCH PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Listed below is information pertaining to the hot lunch program which will begin on Tuesday, September 9.

- * The price of a student is \$2.50.
- * The student lunch includes milk.
- * Milk can be purchased separately for 55 cents.
- * A student can purchase a lunch, on any day, by paying with cash. Students paying with cash will be served after students with meal tickets.
- * Parents can purchase a 10 meal or 20 meal card.
- * A 20-milk card can be purchased.
- * A card will be date-stamped when used.
- * Notes will be sent home to parents when a meal card has three meals remaining.
- * No reminder will be sent home for milk cards.
- * When using checks to purchase meal and or milk cards, write checks to Big Hollow School District for the exact amount and include the deposit slip you received with the monthly menu.
- * Menus posted on the website are for daily information and not for ordering purposes.
- * Hot lunch will include an entrée, two side dishes and a milk.
- * Primary and elementary students will have one daily entrée choice.
- * Students in grades 5-8 will choose one of seven items for their entrée.
- * Students in grades 6-8 will be able to purchase ala carte items for cash only. Ala carte items will include items such as, ice cream, fruit roll-ups, water, juice, cookies, etc. If you have further questions, please contact the middle school.
