## Yearbooks



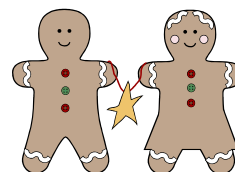
Our team would like to wish you a Happy 2010 and are looking forward to celebrating with your child the great American musical style known as JAZZ.
