

HOW YOUR SCHOOL RATES

Each year, the Illinois State Board of Education releases school report cards for each public school in the state. The report cards include student scores on the Illinois Standards Achievement and Prairie State

Achievement tests, and ACTs, demographic information on students and teachers, and financial information on school districts. The state does not release report cards for private and parochial schools.
