It Items of Public Concern, Mrs. Amy Orr addressed the Board regarding another alleged bus incident. Board member Gallichio directed Mrs. Orr to contact Assistant Principal Smith to address the issue. It was noted that Principal Arndt was not contacted, per the February Board meeting, about previous alleged bus incidents.

Board member Gallichio presented information about the number of Big Hollow graduates who are ranked in the academic top ten, in the four grade levels, at Grant High School.

Mrs. Kristina Bielak reported about the Rising Stars 4-H Club fundraiser. The 4-H Club's goal is to secure rain barrel(s) for the school district that would be used for the Adopt-An-Island Program.
